DAYTON, Ohio, December 15, 1972 --- Nancy Jo Gump, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph A. Gump of 8507 Hallnorth Drive, graduates with honors at the first diploma exercises of the University of Dayton's 123rd Commencement, on December 16. The cum laude student, who averaged 3.6 for an overall grade point, will graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Computer Science.

Employed in UD's computer science department since the second term of her freshman year, she was student instructor for a laboratory course in analog computers, during the recent semester. The course was developed jointly by the biology and computer science departments, to encourage biology majors to employ the computer more in their research. Nancy aided in the planning and construction of the course.

Nancy served as secretary for UD's Student Chapter of the Association for Computing Machinery, a professional, international organization for computer scientists. She also was active in intramural bowling, volley ball, and baseball.

A graduate of Mentor High School, Nancy begins work January 8 at the McDonnell Douglas Automation Co., in St. Louis, Missouri, as a Programmer Trainee in the Business Systems Programming Department. She hopes to attend graduate school part-time next fall.
