## **PAUL AUSTIN TO PERFORM IN UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON RECITAL**

DAYTON, Ohio -- Paul Austin, a visiting horn faculty member at the University of Dayton, will perform in recital at 8 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 11, in Kennedy Union Boll Theatre on campus. Admission is free and open to the public.

The recital will include compositions for horn and piano by Randall Faust, Bertold Hummel and Franz Strauss. An appearance by the Emery Wind Quintet will feature Ingolf Dahl's "Allegro and Arioso." Austin will also perform Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's "First Horn Concerto" on the historic natural horn, the instrument for which Mozart composed his concerti. Cincinnati Opera pianist Phillip Farris will accompany the recital.

Austin has performed throughout the United States, including recent solo appearances in New Mexico, Tennessee and Ohio. In addition to the UD post, Austin is currently on the preparatory faculty at the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music, where he is completing a doctorate in horn performance. He also teaches horn for the Dayton Public Schools and is a member of the Dayton Philharmonic and Richmond Symphony Orchestras.
