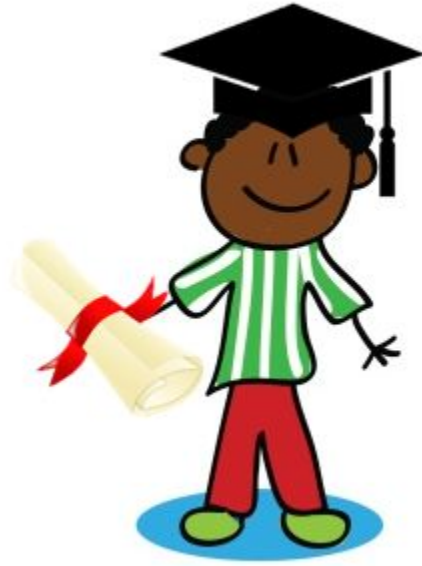

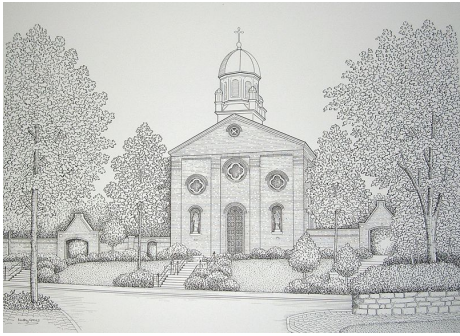


ENTREPRENEURSHIP

We have a broad vision for this program but need to start small with programs like Fridays for the Future. A controlled and cautious growth ensures the best possible experience for each child involved.



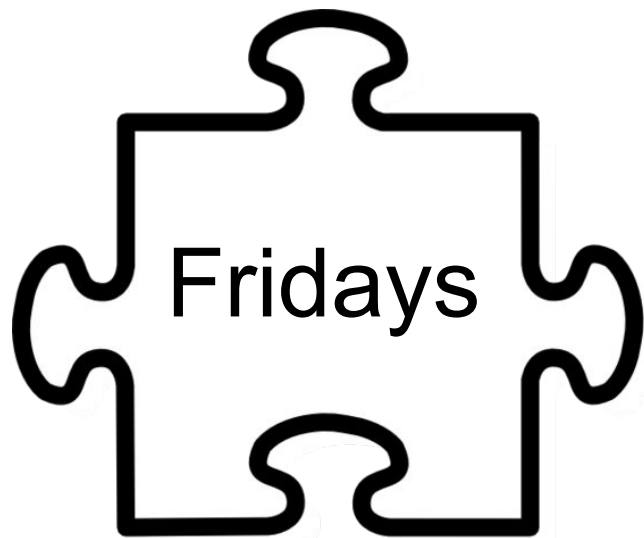
MENTORSHIP AWARENESS CAMPAIGN
