**MONDAY, MARCH 23: TONY HALL TO RECEIVE SOCIAL JUSTICE AWARD AT UD**

U.S. Rep. Tony P. Hall, D-Dayton, internationally known for his work with the poor and hungry, will receive the Joseph Cinqué Social Justice Award from the Black Law Student Association at the University of Dayton on Monday, March 23.

"Tony Hall was selected because of his outspoken and continuous stance on hunger and poverty. It's a stance he keeps in front of everything he does," said Vernellia Randall, law professor and adviser to the Black Law Student Association. "He also stepped out front and put an apology on the table about slavery. It was a brave thing to do. A sincere apology is the first step toward healing."

Hall, who was nominated for the 1998 Nobel Peace Prize, will speak about "Making a Difference in the World Community" at noon in the Mathias Heck Courtroom in Joseph E. Keller Hall on campus. He will be presented the Joseph Cinqué Social Justice Award during a program that begins at 5:45 p.m. in the courtroom. His remarks during the program will focus on human rights for the underprivileged. Both talks are open to the public.
