Congressman Charles W. Whalen, Jr. will return to Dayton Thursday (Jan. 26) for the first time since taking office.

He will remain in the district through Tuesday.

On Whalen's schedule will be the swearing-in of 28 Deputy Congressmen in his district office in the post office building at 10 a.m., Saturday.

The Deputies, who are unsalaried, were nominated by Whalen during the campaign.

He also plans to make door-to-door visits--similar to those conducted during last year's campaign.

"I found this direct contact to be invaluable in getting to know what the people are thinking," Whalen said.

In addition, he will speak before the Executive Development Association of the Defense Electronics Supply Center at noon Monday at DESC. His subject will be "Prospects for the 90th Congress."
