Toilet Paper Roll Animal Crafts: Bald Eagle

Instructions:

1. Print out the templates from the link below. The first template includes head, feet, tail, tummy, and large brown rectangle to wrap around the tube for the body. The second link includes the wings.
2. Color (where appropriate) and cut out the template pieces.
3. Glue the large rectangular piece on first to cover the tube. Toilet paper rolls come in different sizes, so if you find the rectangle is a bit too big, just trim it down. If you find it's a bit too small, just cut out another small piece to fill in the gap.
4. Glue the tummy onto the front of the toilet paper roll
5. Glue the tail on to the back of the toilet paper roll.
6. Glue the head onto the front of the toilet paper roll.
7. Glue the wings onto the back to make it look like the eagle is flying.
8. Fold the feet and glue tabs to the inside of the tube.
