**Meeting Minutes**

I. CALL TO ORDER

Madhuri Kango-Singh called the meeting to order at 2.00 PM.

II. ROLL CALL

III. Business

a. Department of Geology related (Dr. Shuang-Ye Wu was invited to this discussion)

1. Geology: Program Change BS-EVG and BS-Geo
2. Geology courses : A number of courses were reviewed by the NSSC
  - I. The courses below were reviewed for 'pre-requisite change' and
    1. GEO109L - for CAP 4yr review
    2. GEO115L - for CAP 4yr review
    3. GEO115 - for CAP 4 yr review
    4. GEO 302 -
    5. GEO 201L-

    7. GEO 303- for CAP 4yr review
    8. SCI 210L- for CAP 4yr review

II. For the courses below the proposer was asked to add ILGs, and NSSC reviewed the new program changes:

1. GEO 302
2. GEO 307
3. GEO 309
4. GEO 455

Dr. Shaung-Ye Wu presented the committee with the rationale behind realigning the BS-EVG and BS-GEO programs, the sequence of introductory courses, and the rationale for flexibility in the program

for incoming students from Business, Engineering or Discover Science students. These documents are shared with the Executive Committee.

The NSSC has reviewed the program changes, the pre-requisite changes and revisions/additions of ILGs, and after clarifications/discussion with the Chair of the Department of Geology (Dr. Wu), we recommend approval for the program and pre-requisite changes.

b. Department of Biology related

1. Neuroscience Minor: New Minor
2. BIO301L: Evolution Lab: New Course Proposal
3. BIO470: Cancer Biology: Course Revision

The NSSC reviewed the Neuroscience Minor- this minor is vetted and approved by the Department of Biology. The committee reviewed this Minor, and recommends it for full AAC approval.

The NSSC reviewed the BIO301L which is a new laboratory course for EVB/BIO majors. This course is approved by the Department. The committee approves the course. One recommendation communicated to the Department is to add this course to the Course Catalog.

NSSC approved the revision to BIO470, an existing course in which CLOS, ILGS and Pre-and Co-requisites were revised.

The NSSC reviewed the New Minor and New course proposals
