Shorelight Education - Jason Reinoehl, vice president for strategic enrollment management, presented background information regarding the challenges in recruitment and retention of international students, nationally and at UD. Pathway programs were defined and identified as a potential avenue to pursue in order to assist with international student recruitment and retention. Advantages and disadvantages of partnerships were discussed, and initial research on two 3rd party pathway providers were provided. The leadership team of one firm, Shorelight Education, was invited to campus on Nov. 11 for further information gathering. Faculty members of the ELC will be invited to participate in December meetings with Shorelight Education leaders as the University continues to explore this opportunity.
