If you see a Congressman at your door sometime this weekend, don't be surprised.

Congressman Charles W. Whalen, Jr. will return to the district for a three-day visit and plans at least one door-to-door tour of a precinct. (CWW)

Whalen made the house-to-house technique a trademark during the campaign last year when he covered more than 250 of the Third District's precincts.

The former State Senator also will make two speeches. The first will be at 6:30 p.m. before the Pilot Club of Kettering at The Inn. The second will be before divinity students at the United Theological Seminary at 7:30 p.m. Friday at Robert Hall Lounge.

His remarks will be on the outlook for the 90th Congress.

Whalen also will hold office hours in the Congressional District office located in the Dayton Post Office building on West Third Street.

In addition, he will participate in the Vandalia-Butler Republican Club Lincoln Day program Saturday evening.

He will arrive Thursday afternoon (Feb. 16) at 3:41 p.m. via American Flight 719 and depart Sunday at 3:10 p.m. on TWA Flight 522.
