**University Budget update**

Executive Vice President Andy Horner reviewed the budget presentation provided at the January Board of Trustee meetings. He shared the University's financial position dashboard, updated members regarding the University's financial ratings, reviewed revenue and expense trends, and discussed net tuition trends and forecasts. Following this macro-level outlook, Andy identified the highlights of recent progress in relation to the University's fiscal stewardship principles of 1) invest in ourselves, 2) plan and target, and 3) common sense spending practices.

**St. Patrick's Day debrief**

St. Patrick's Day, which coincided this year with spring break move-in, was relatively quiet and uneventful. There were some neighborhood gatherings, which began late afternoon but had ended by early evening. There were no reports of excessive behavior and few safety issues noted.

Eric Spina expressed his gratitude for the work of many campus departments, in particular Student Development, SGA, and public safety.

**Other**

A question about future academic calendars was raised. The calendar committee is currently working on the academic calendars for 2020 and beyond. The calendar committee will share their recommendations with ECAS followed by a presentation to Provost Council prior to finalizing.

A brief discussion occurred regarding the recently announced college admissions scandals and how that news might impact UD.
