Congressman Charles W. Whalen, Jr. today announced that the Washington Township Board of Education shortly will receive a check for \$50,503 from the Office of Education.

Whalen said the grant is part of a \$67,338 tentative entitlement for the district for fiscal year 1967.

The funds are provided to schools as federal assistance for current expenses for schools in federally-impacted areas.
