Finals week craft:

Sustainably supplied ornaments

Supplies

- ¾-inch-wide strips of pages from discarded books, cut to three lengths: 6.5, 5.5, 4.5 inches
- Stapler and staples
- Hole punch
- 3/16 inch curling ribbon or other fabric ribbon, cut to 24-inch lengths

Instructions

1. Take five strips: 2 long, 2 medium, 1 short. Stack them in this order, aligning all five at one end.
 - Long
 - Medium
 - Short
 - Medium
 - Long
2. Staple the strips together about ½ inch from the end. This is the bottom of the ornament.
3. Carefully align the other ends of the strips.
4. Staple the ends together about ¾ inch from that end. This is the top of the ornament. Punch a hole just above the top staple.
5. Feed a ribbon through the hole and pull it through to the middle of the ribbon. Tie a knot in the ribbon about 3 inches from the top of the ornament; if desired, tie the remaining tails of the ribbon into a bow or other decorative knot.
6. Go forth and deck a bough.
