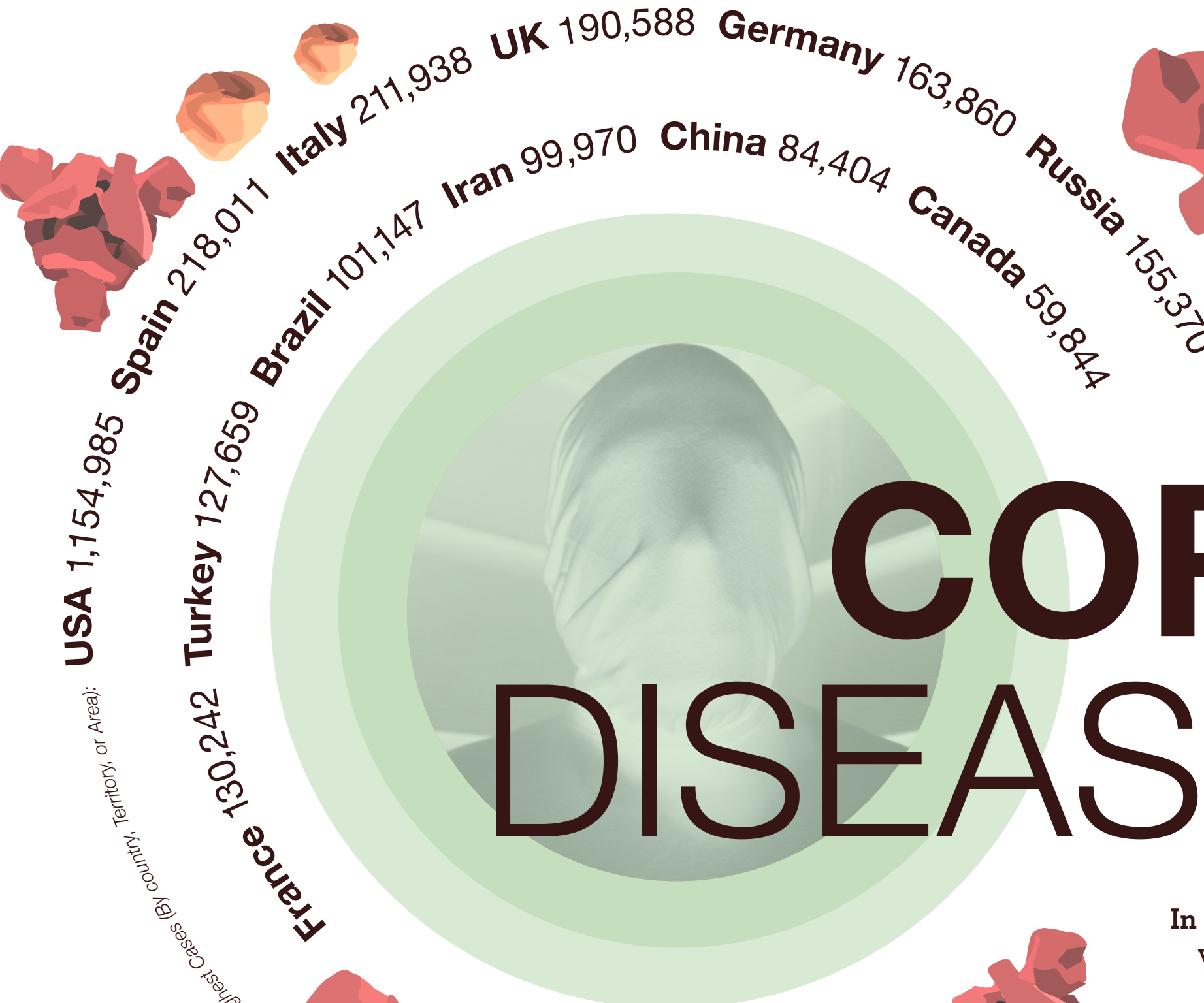


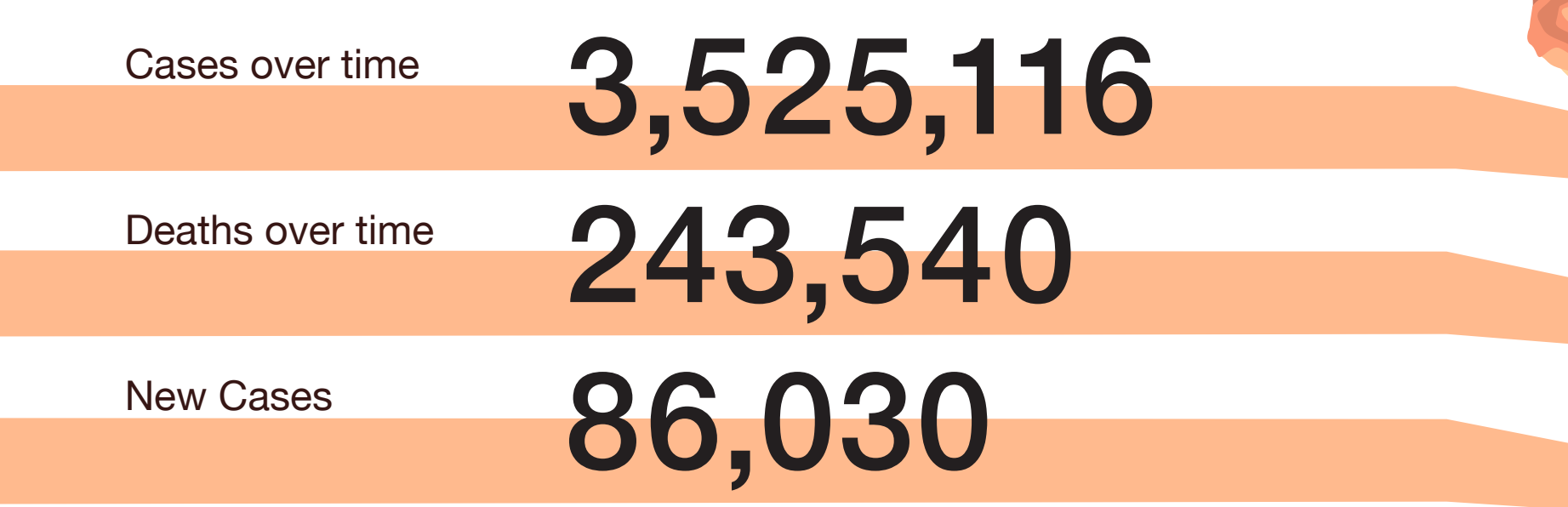
Pandemic 2020



World Health Organization (WHO) announced "COVID-19" as the name of this new disease on 11 February 2020.

CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)

In COVID-19, 'CO' stands for 'corona,' 'VI' for 'virus,' and 'D' for disease. Formerly, this disease was referred to as "2019 novel coronavirus" or "2019-nCoV". There are many types of human coronaviruses including some that commonly cause mild upper-respiratory tract illnesses.



Official names have been announced for the virus responsible for COVID-19 (previously known as "2019 novel coronavirus") and the disease it causes. The official names are: **Disease**, coronavirus disease, (COVID-19), **VIRUS**, severe acute respiratory syndrome, coronavirus 2, (**SARS-CoV-2**)
