### UD'S PRIDE OF DAYTON MARCHING BAND TO PERFORM FOR HOMETOWN AUDIENCE

DAYTON, Ohio — The University of Dayton marching band, Pride of Dayton, will be performing its only on-campus concert this season at 2 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 15, in the Jesse Philips Humanities Center plaza.

The Pride of Dayton marching band consists of 135 members, including the Flyerette dancers. Under the direction of Jim Latten, assistant professor of music at UD, the men and women of the UD band will be performing selections from their pre-game and half-time shows.

The concert will feature well known songs like the "Mission Impossible" theme, "In the Stone" by Earth, Wind and Fire, "Lucretia MacEvil" by Blood Sweat and Tears and "Too Much" by the Dave Matthews Band. On top of these hit songs, they will perform standard favorites such as the "Victory March," "Dayton Anthem" and "Loyalty."
