### **SATURDAY, NOV. 11 UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON STUDENTS WILL CLEAN UP PRAIRIE**

Between 12 and 25 University of Dayton students are expected to take advantage of mild weather for an end-of-fall clean-up at the Bergamo Center at Mount St. John **Saturday, Nov. 11**. The retreat center is located at 4400 Shakertown Road. Students from the University's Marianist Environmental Education Club will begin working at **1 p.m.** and are expected to work for two to three hours.

Students will work the grounds in a land service project to remove invasive species — predominantly honeysuckle — in the prairie, which is part of a 100-acre natural reserve of prairie, woodland and wetland at the center.

MEEC president Kelly Stanforth said students from several other campus service organizations have volunteered to help with the land service project.
