UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON RIKE CENTER GALLERY FEATURING EXHIBIT OF 'PAINTING AS LANDSCAPE'

DAYTON, Ohio — The Rike Center gallery at the University of Dayton is currently featuring "Painting as Landscape," an exhibit of two dozen pieces created "en pleinair" — art created outside and directly from nature — through Nov. 3.

The exhibit, which is free and open to the public, features the work of award-winning artists and art educators Glen Cebulash of Dayton and Ying Li of New York. Gallery hours are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesdays and Wednesdays, 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. Thursdays and 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Fridays.

Cebulash, assistant professor of art at Wright State University, created his pieces in oil on paper during the spring and summer of 1999 and 2000.

Li, assistant professor of art faculty at Haverford College in Haverford, Penn., created her pieces in acrylic on panel while on site in Vermont and Italy during the summer of 1999.

To complement his display, Cebulash will give a "gallery talk" at noon on Wednesday, Oct. 25, in the Rike Center gallery. The discussion is also free and open to the public.
