FOR RELEASE UPON RECEIPT

Congressman Charles W. Whalen, Jr., today announced that a pay raise of approximately 13 cents an hour--equal to \$270 per year--has been authorized for 4,398 wage board employees at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base.

Whalen said the new schedule will add almost \$1.2 million to the base's annual payroll.

It will go into effect for the first pay period beginning on or after Wednesday, March 29th.

The increase will apply to 1,150 Aeronautical Systems Division personnel and 3,248 other Wright-Patterson employees.
