### NEW HORIZONS BAND MAKING DEBUT IN CONCERT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON

DAYTON, Ohio — The University of Dayton's New Horizons Band will make its musical debut during a holiday concert with the University's symphonic wind ensemble. The joint concert will be at 7 p.m. Sunday, Dec. 3, in the Kennedy Union Boll Theatre. Admission is free.

Brand new to UD this fall, the New Horizons Band is an ensemble designed for senior citizens who have never played a musical instrument before or are getting reacquainted with long-neglected playing skills. The group is directed by Linda Hartley, coordinator of music education at the University.

The concert will feature a variety of Christmas songs performed by the New Horizons Band, including *Hark the Herald Angels Sing*, *Jingle Bells* and *Joy to the World*. A performance of *Go Tell in On the Mountain* which will feature small ensembles from within the band.

The symphonic wind ensemble, directed Patrick Reynolds, associate professor of music, will include a variety of classical pieces including with *Toccata with Fugue* by Johann Sebastian Bach.
