### **FRIDAY, DEC. 1: UD CHRISTMAS TREE WILL BE CUT, MOVED AND TRIMMED IN PREPARATION FOR CHRISTMAS ON CAMPUS CELEBRATION**

In the spirit of the University of Dayton's 37th annual Christmas on Campus celebration, "Dr. Woody" and crew from Woody Tree Medics in Kettering will donate their services **Friday, Dec. 1** to help bring a Christmas tree to campus. The city of Dayton department of parks and recreation and Dayton Power & Light are also donating manpower to help move the live tree once it's been cut.

Work is scheduled to begin at 8 a.m., when Woody Tree Medics cutters take down the 35-foot evergreen from a student house at 621 Irving Ave. The actual cutting is estimated to take between 30 minutes and one hour. Once the tree is cut, personnel from DP&L and the city of Dayton will help remove the tree from the property and deliver it to its place of honor in the Kennedy Union plaza.

At the plaza, personnel from the University's department of facilities management will erect the tree, and students from the Christmas on Campus committee will begin decorating with lights and large silver and white snowflakes. They'll then add more than 60 handmade ornaments created by young art students at Webster and Lincoln elementary schools in Dayton. The finishing touch will be placement of a star created by students from UD's art department. Decorators expect to spend most of the day working on the tree.

UD's Christmas on Campus celebration will be held Friday, Dec. 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. The event is designed to bring University students, faculty and staff together with Miami Valley residents and local elementary school students for a festive, campus-wide holiday celebration that includes crafts, concerts, carnival activities, visits with Santa and more.
