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ABOUT THE ARTIST

Sarah Hall is an internationally recognized stained glass artist whose work has received numerous awards for outstanding liturgical art from the Interfaith Forum on Religion, Art and Architecture and Ministry and Liturgy. In 1996, the Ontario Association of Architects honored Sarah with the OAA Allied Arts Award for her contribution to the built environment. Recently completed is her largest stained glass project - a three-thousand square foot window wall for St. Andrew Church in Columbus, Ohio.



Sarah attended the Architectural Glass Program at Swansea College of Art in Wales, UK and earned her Diploma in Architectural Glass from the City & Guilds of London Institute in 1977. She assisted Lawrence Lee, Glass Master at the Royal College of Art, following this with eight months in Jerusalem studying Middle Eastern techniques in glass. In 1980 Sarah established her studio in Toronto and keeps a busy international schedule with lectures, exhibitions and projects.

In addition to studio work, Sarah and co-author Jeffrey Kraegel have over thirty published articles on technical, historic and artistic aspects of stained glass. *The Color of Light* is Sarah's first book and a unique contribution to the stained glass field.

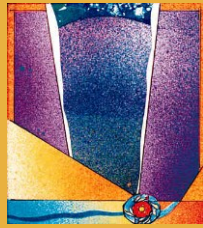
