The Miryam Award Committee has selected Dr. Shauna Adams and Shane White for this year's recipients of the Miryam Award. These two individuals exemplify the spirit of the Miryam Award and are great role models for demonstrating how to transfer personal passion into effective, positive social change.

Dr. Adams is an Assoc. Professor in the School of Education and Health Sciences and the Executive Director of the Center for Early Learning. Shauna's continued leadership and support of women in education has led her to serve as a role model, mentor and springboard for many women at UD including the development of a curriculum to better serve working mothers who wish to continue their education.

Shane White serves as the Assoc. Director of University Information Systems. Shane volunteers his time as a broadcaster and promoter of UD women's basketball. He has also served as a broadcaster for the women's volleyball team, and he supports the athletics communications department in all home event management. His dedication to women's athletics seems unbounded. A nominee stated "Shane is the epitome of the university community - comprehensive, Catholic and Marianist value - he exists not for himself, but to render service."


