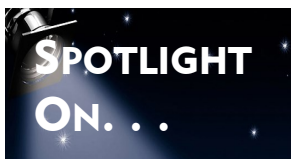

Featured Marianist Mission

Another recipient of money collected for Marianists abroad this Lent will be Marianist Sisters' Health Clinics in Kpatchile, Togo, West Africa and Singhpur, Jharkhand, India. Chaminade Health Care Center in India was dedicated in September 2012 to serve the students and families of the rural parish and the Marianist School. In October 2011, the Marianist Sisters opened a Rural Health Care Center in Kpatchile, Togo outside of Kara. Part of its mission is to provide maternity and well-baby care for people who previously had no medical assistance. The Sisters need help raising Sr. Ann Martine's salary and that of the other medical personnel who serve the rural poor.



Chapel Renovation

Our beloved Chapel of the Immaculate Conception will soon be receiving the loving attention that it has needed to preserve its central place in the life of our community. Renovation begins this summer 2014 with an anticipated completion in the summer of 2015.

The chapel will remain the primary liturgical space for the University of Dayton. The renovation will:

- create the best possible liturgical space that meets the requirements of today's liturgy, using appropriate Church documents as a guide;
- respect the historical dimensions of the chapel;
- remain within the limits of the chapel's present footprint with some modest expansion to the south for service areas including restrooms;
- fashion a more harmonious aesthetic between windows, walls, flooring, liturgical pieces, art work, etc. to enhance the chapel's beauty;
- provide universal accessibility and meet other building code requirements;
- be a LEED certified project with emphasis on sustainability in the use of materials and design.

Once the renovation is complete, the chapel will be a harmonious and beautiful space to celebrate more fully our faith in liturgy and sacrament. It will unite all of the elements of the chapel into a warm, unified whole that retains essential traditions and history.

We invite you to hear more design details and view the current plans at an upcoming chapel Information Session, highlighted in this bulletin. Also, we will bless the UD community's leave-taking of our chapel at all Masses the weekend of April 27. Please pray for the success of this important project.

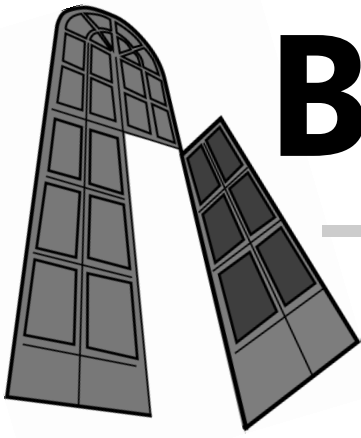
