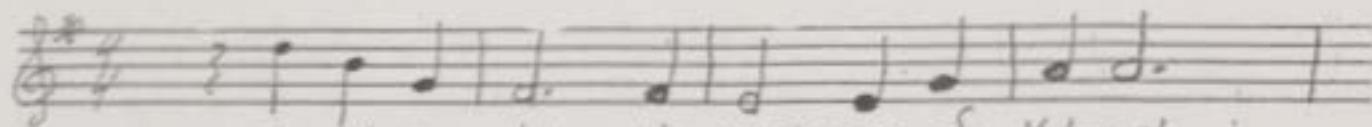
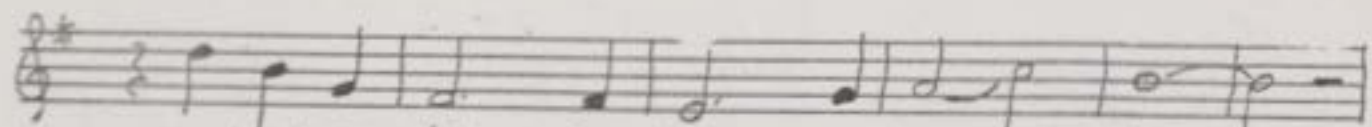

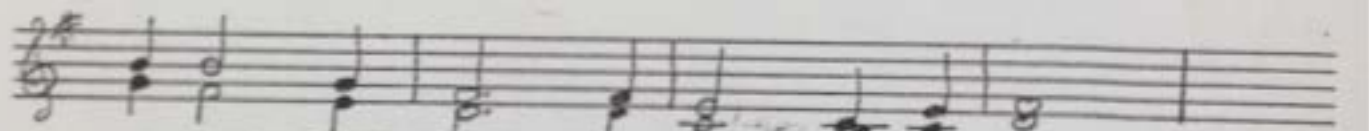
I will pro-claim the great-ness of Yah-weh,
