DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:

The Administration created the Tuition Exchange Program for Employees in 1997-98 with implementation beginning in the Fall of 1998. The Faculty Affairs Committee has oversight on this issue. This semester the committee met with representatives of Human Resources and corresponded with Mr. Jim Kelly, Director of Scholarship. Currently, the program allows for three participants for three years. In reviewing this policy, the Faculty Affairs Committee was interested in whether the program could be expanded to include more employees and still remain viable. The suggestion was made consistent with Mr. Kelly's recommendation that we could probably expand to six slots and maintain parity between incoming and exchange students.

1. The Tuition Exchange Program should be continued. In addition, the number of new enrollees should be increased to an average of six slots annually, in order to make the program accessible to more interested employees.
