DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:

On December 3, 1999, the Academic Policies Committee submitted a proposal (No. 99-8), University General and Graduation Competency Program, which was approved. In that document, Recommendation IV recommended and elaborated on the establishment and functioning of the Competency Implementation Subcommittee.

The proposal in this senate document 00-02 is to amend the membership section of Recommendation IV with regard to the relationship between the General Education Committee and the Competency Implementation Subcommittee. This action would reduce the size of the General Education Committee establishing the chair of the Competency Implementation Subcommittee as a member of the General Education Committee with voting rights. This proposal rescinds the action that established the Competency Implementation Subcommittee as voting members of the General Education Committee, thus making for more effective functioning of both committees.

MEMBERSHIP

The chair of the Competency Implementation Subcommittee is a member of the General Education Committee and will serve as the sole voting representative of the standing Competency Implementation Subcommittee.
