Imagine nine weeks living a very simple lifestyle in community and being a part of a service program that plays and instructs young children in our Day Camp program, allows you to befriend and walk with teens through our Teen Center program, and also visit the elderly in the local nursing home, in Salyersville, Kentucky!

The UDSAP program reflects UD's Catholic and Marianist heritage of living in community, building a strong faith life and doing meaningful service. Our hope is that each UD student who participates in this program will build strong and lasting relationships with the youth and their families in Appalachia and continue these relationships through continued visits during the following school year.

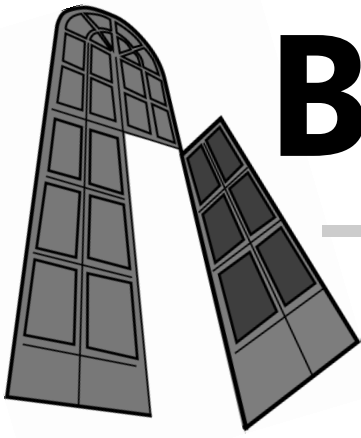
