1. Announcements: The next APC meeting is October 25 from 2 to 4:00 pm in Kennedy Union.
2. New Business: Review of the “Processes and Procedures of the Academic Senate” document. No action needed.
3. Revisions to the Transfer Credit & Related Policies (DOC I-10-05)
 - A. In the Proposal Section 1 – The words “as well” will be removed from the last sentence of the first paragraph. The sentence should read “Thesis or dissertation credits are not eligible for transfer.”
 - B. In the same section in the beginning of the second paragraph “In general” shall be removed and replaced the sentence should read “Except at the Doctoral level, a maximum of six semester hours of graduate work may be transferred into a graduate degree program.”
 - C. The last paragraph in Proposal Section 1 – should be changed to “Upon the recommendation of the department chair there could be exceptions to this policy, which include articulation agreements made with other universities, may be made with the approval of the Dean of the Graduate School.
 - D. In the Proposal Section 2 – The Residence requirement will be removed.

The changes were voted on and approved by the attending members of the Academic Policies Committee. Ed Mykytka will make the necessary changes and resubmit the document to the Executive Committee of the Academic Senate.
