Posters: Have yours printed at Roesch. It's fast (48-hour turnaround), affordable (\$20 to \$25), versatile (two sizes) ... and in full color.

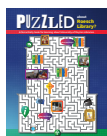
Spaces: We offer online booking for small, medium and large rooms for the various types of work you do: libcal.udayton.edu.
