Congressman Charles W. Whalen, Jr. (R-Ohio) has scheduled a series of mobile trailer tours in the Third Congressional District for the four days following Easter Sunday.

The tours with the mobile office will take him to eight shopping centers in four days, Monday through Thursday, April 15-18.

The purpose of the plan is to make it convenient for constituents to meet with their Congressman.

"I did this last year and found it well worth the effort," Whalen said. "It enables me to get a first-hand contact with the residents and to talk with many people with whom this might not be possible or convenient ordinarily."

The Congressional Easter recess will permit Whalen to return to the District for a lengthier period than usual.
