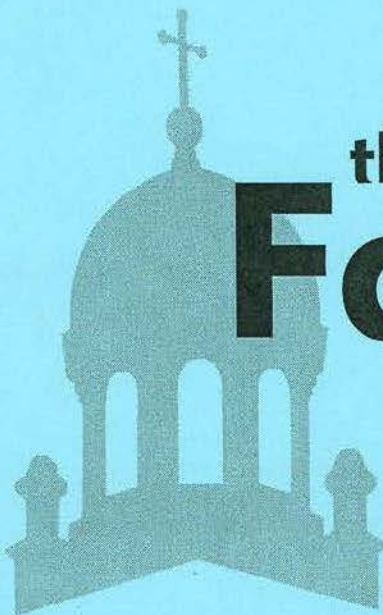

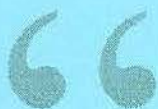

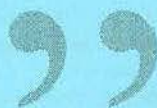

## HUNGRY HEARTS

"You satisfy the hungry heart..."

Is your heart hungry to learn more about the Catholic faith? If so, Hungry Hearts may be the program for you.

Hungry Hearts is a relatively new initiative designed to address the UD community's desire to learn more about specific topics in Catholicism. The casual atmosphere created at Hungry Hearts is one of openness and dialogue in which participants can feel free to explore their questions and concerns.

The program, created and planned by a team of students and campus ministers, is based on the "Theology on Tap" concept. We gather three evenings a semester in the Torch Lounge of Kennedy Union. A presenter offers guiding thoughts and leads the group in conversation. There is always plenty of free coffee and desserts to share as well.

Last semester Hungry Hearts addressed Protestant - Catholic Dialogue, Theology of the Body, and the Catholic Response to Violence. The first Hungry Hearts of the current semester addressed Being Present to Christ's Presence in the Eucharist.

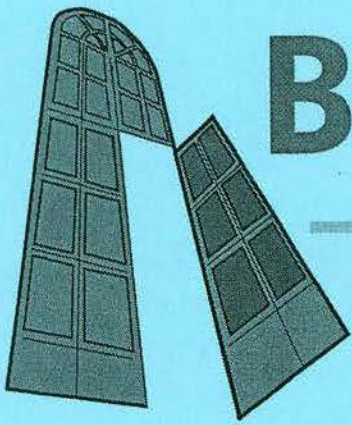
