Recommended Policy

To earn an additional bachelor's degree, a student must successfully complete at least 30 semester hours at UD which did not apply to the first degree and which fulfill all specific major and specific college and university degree requirements in force at the time of enrollment at UD for the additional degree. Appropriate courses may count for both degrees; consult the Dean's office.
