PORCH COMMUNITIES

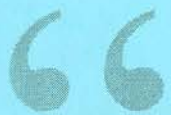

In campus ministry a PORCH Community is a small faith-sharing group: a safe place to gather with people, usually once a week to talk about life and how God might be working in it. It's a place for meaningful conversation and a community of support. PORCH stands for People Of Respect, Compassion and Hope. It's a place for you, wherever you might be on your faith journey.

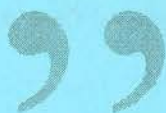

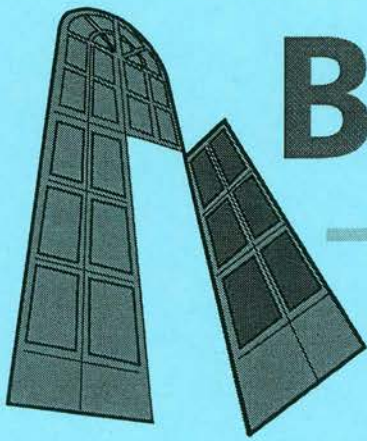
