DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:

This policy was developed to respond to the guidelines developed by the National Science Foundation requiring that grantee institutions employing more than 50 persons maintain their own conflict of interest policies. It also requires certification from investigators and authorized institutional representatives.

The policy is also designed to help researchers understand their duties and responsibilities in resolving possible conflicts.
