INCUNABULA

Two especially valuable books have come to the Marian Library this past month through the work of Brother Benito Moral S.M. of Madrid. Both of these publications are of the seventeenth century and are extremely rare items. One by Hyacinth Choquet, entitled *MARIAE DEEPARAE IN ORDINEM PRAEDICATORUM VIS-CERA MATERNA* is dated 1634 and was published at Antwerp. The other is *LOS DISCURSOS..en defensa de la Inmaculada Concepcion*, published in Madrid in 1614.

MARIANUM

MARIANUM, the quarterly review of scientific Mariology, published by the Servites of the International Marian Commission in Rome, is seeking to further and become increasingly helpful to greater numbers of the English speaking clergy, professors, and students in theological schools, librarians, writers--in a word, to all those living in countries where English is spoken, who have a scholarly interest in Marian theology.

MARIANUM, the oldest and foremost review of its kind, is, therefore, trying to provide more articles in English and Latin than in the past. The Marian Library will be happy to supply interested persons with literature describing *Marianum*. Information can also be secured from the Servite Fathers at 3111 Van Buren St., Chicago 12, Ill. Two articles of special interest which appear in the first 1952 issue are "Our Lady's Co-Redemption in the Marian Literature of the Nineteenth Century America" by Fr. Juniper B. Carol, O.F.M. and "The Mariology of G.K. Chesterton" by Father James M. Keane, O.S.M.

NEW MARIAN ENCYCLOPEDIA

The Servite Fathers in Rome are right now at work on the publication of a Marian Encyclopedia under the direction of the Very Reverend James M. Keane, O.S.M., founder of the Perpetual Novena to Our Sorrowful Mother in Chicago. Father Keane is being assisted by Father Gerard Calkins O.S.M., assistant editor. In conjunction with the encyclopedia offices in Rome, the Servites have opened a MARIAN BOOK-SHOP which stocks books in all languages on the Blessed Virgin exclusively. We are grateful to Father Calkins for the assistance he has given us in securing foreign publications through this new Marian bookstore. Father Calkins just secured for us a complete set of *SUMMA AUREA de LAUDIBUS BVM*, in Latin in 13 volumes, well-bound, in good condition for \$110.00. Thanks, Father, for your splendid help.

MARIAN PAMPHLETS

The Marian Library has also received pamphlets on Marian topics the past several months from Mission Press, Society of Divine Word, Techy, Ill; from Raymond A Punda of Milwaukee, Wis.; from Reverend Raymond Cadwallader of Elizabeth, Pa.; from the Redemptorists of Esopus, N.Y.; from Father O'Mahony of Dublin, Ireland; from the Benedictine Sisters of Liege, Belgium, etc. We are grateful for these booklets. Thank you, authors, publishers, donors for the complimentary copies sent to the Marian Library, which copies certainly make our pamphlet collection grow.

MARIAN REPRINTS

Subscriptions to Marian Reprints are climbing toward the 600 mark. Several bulk orders from Catholic Bookstores have helped the increase. Reprint Number 4 (April 1952) will be a selection from *The Mother of Jesus*, an older work by the Marist Father Placid Huault, which has been long out of print. The book has been highly recommended by readers and reviewers since its original publication in Australia in 1906, and we are happy to be able to put at least a small part of it back into circulation through Marian Reprint Number 4.

BOOK NOTES

This is Fatima, by Rev. Joseph M. Agius, O.P. mentioned in the last issue of Newsletter, is available in the United States from M.A. Rush, 314 S.W. Washington St., Portland, Ore. Price is 25¢. Father Agius plans an American edition with additional material on the Immaculate Heart... Father Joan de Marchi, whose *Crusade of Fatima* was one of the first books on the topic, is scheduled to come out with an American edition of his latest work, *Fatima--the Facts*, which has already been published in Ireland. Stephen Breen, associate director of the Scapular Apostolate, has a new book off the press, *Recent Apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary...* It is distributed by the Scapular Press, 338 East 29th St., New York 15, N.Y. The English translation of Jean Guillemin's *La Vierge Marie* will be published by Kenada this spring. Publication was postponed from October. Several chapters of this work were included in Frank Saeed's *Mary Book*.

A NEW PARISIAN CONTACT

THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF "ARTISANS D'ART ET DE FOI" WROTE US FEBRUARY 6TH ABOUT THE CENTRE MARIAL FRANCAIS. THE LETTER IS TOO LONG TO QUOTE VERBATIM BUT IN IT, MR. REVIERS DE MAUNY SAYS THAT THEY HAVE AN EXTREMELY IMPORTANT DOCUMENTATION ON THE MARIAN SANCTUARIES OF FRANCE, NUMBERING 35,000 TYPED PAGES IT IS A TEN YEAR WORK, GIVING THE HISTORY, ARCHAEOLOGY AND LEGENDS OF ALL THESE SANCTUARIES. THEY HAVE BEGUN A COLLECTION OF THE MOST ANCIENT BOOKS ON MARY, AND IN AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE ARE SEEKING ORIGINAL MARIAN WORKS. THESE PEOPLE HAVE VISITED 114 PARISHES OF FRANCE WITH AN ITINERANT EXPOSITION. THEY GIVE CONFERENCES, THEY HAVE HAD 1836 EXPOSITION OPENINGS, THEY HAVE CONTACTED ABOUT 100,000 PEOPLE. THESE EXPOSITIONS HAVE BEEN HELD IN PARIS, LYONS, NANCY, REIMS, MOROCCO, CASABLANCA. THIS IS, WE BELIEVE, A VERY SINGULAR WORK DEVOTED TO OUR BLESSED MOTHER.

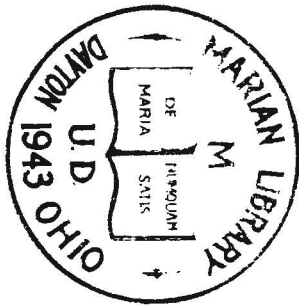
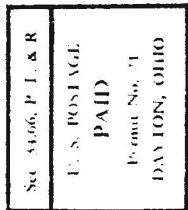
