MARIAN REPRINTS

The first series of MARIAN REPRINTS will be completed in December with issue number ten. Number nine, Russia and the Immaculate Heart, the apostolic letter of Pius XII addressed to the Russian peoples, will be mailed this month. The second series of REPRINTS will begin in January, and we urge our friends whose subscriptions will expire in December to send in a renewal as soon as possible. We feel that there is a great need for solid, apostolic literature on the Blessed Virgin. We hope that in continuing to publish MARIAN REPRINTS we will be able to help fill this need.

MARIANIST AWARD 1952

Within the month the University of Dayton will announce the 1952 winner of the Marianist Award, given annually to the person who, in the opinion of the nominating committee, has contributed greatly to the honor of the Blessed Virgin. The first such award was given to Father Juniper B. Carol, OFM, president of the Mariological Society of America, in 1950. The second award went to Father Daniel A. Lord, S. J., in 1951. The award will be bestowed in December of this year at the University. Watch for the announcement in your diocesan paper.

MARIAN CONVENTION

The fourth National Convention of the American Mariological Society will be held in Cleveland the first week of January 1953. Those who can ought to prepare now to attend this Convention, at which scholarly papers and discussions on Our Blessed Mother take place. In all probability, the winners of the Society's Contest on THE DIVINE AND SPIRITUAL MATERNITY OF MARY will be announced at this Convention. All are welcome to attend the Convention.

FILMS

It was suggested to us by the FAMILY ROSARY of Hollywood, that we establish information on the whereabouts of films on Mary. The latter would be too expensive a project for us to undertake now. However, our film-PEACE PLAN FROM HEAVEN, which has been shown to at least 200 different audiences, is at the moment in Montana. FRANCISCAN PROJECT

A union catalogue of books on Mary in the Franciscan libraries throughout the United States will be published in 1954 to mark the centenary of the dogma of the Immaculate Conception. Father Ralph Ohlman, O.F.M., of Cincinnati, is chairman of the project. This is the definite step forward in the field of Marian literature as it will assist Marian scholars in locating existing works throughout the country and will supplement the union catalogue which is now in the Marian Library.
