### MARIAN LIBRARY DONORS

### A MARIAN-LIBRARY STUDY

Another first for the Library is the publication of a Marian-Library STUDY, which is due this month, and in a 6 x 9 inch format. It is the hope of the Marian Library to issue one of these studies periodically at 50¢ the copy.

The first of these is on FILIAL PIETY & HOLY SLAVERY--two different types of devotion to Mary. The first was preached by Father William Chamblaine, Founder of the Society of Mary; the second was initiated by St. Grignon de Montfort,, founder of the Company of Mary. 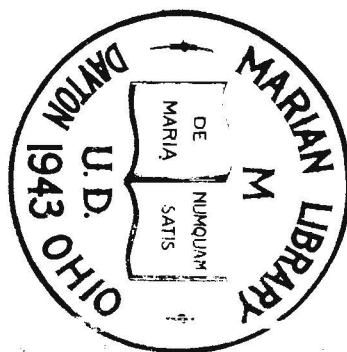
