Currently a full time undergraduate student pays a flat tuition to take anywhere from 12 to 17 hours. If a student wants to take more than 17 hours, an additional fee per credit hour must be paid. *not in the honors program,*

The Student Academic Policies Committee recommends that the University change the maximum hours allowed to be taken for the standard full time tuition rate from 17 to 18. This change would provide students with more flexibility in scheduling classes. Students who want to explore other courses would be more inclined to do that; students who are capable of taking overloads to shorten their time to degree could do that.
