This Very Honorable Corporation has received trustworthy news of the singular veneration which your Catholic University professes towards our Exalted Patroness and Queen of Hispanity,

**The MOST HOLY VIRGIN OF THE PILLAR**

For which reason, the Very Illustrious Permanent Municipal Committee of this Very Honorable City Council, in session assembled on the seventh day of June, 1950, has resolved as follows:

- 1st. To donate a Statue of the Most Holy Virgin of the Pillar to the Catholic University of Dayton, Ohio, U.S.A., for its installation in the Marian Library of said educational institution.
- 2nd. To attach at the foot of the Statue a plaque on which this resolution is to be recorded and perpetuated.
- 3rd. That this Statue be shipped by way of the diplomatic pouch of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to His Excellency, Don Pablo Merry del Val, to be forwarded by him in the name of this Corporation.

Which in compliance with said resolution, I have the honor to communicate to Your Excellency by means of the present despatch.

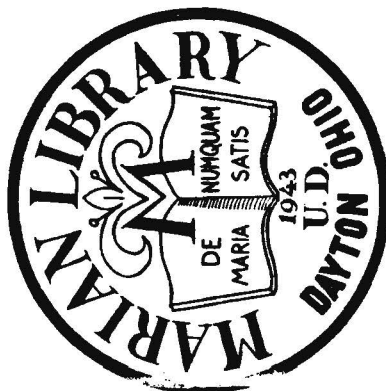
