DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:

(Note: The following sentence is to be added as the second sentence of the last paragraph on page G-2.3 of the Faculty Handbook, under the heading "DEFICIENCY REPORTS". The new wording includes all students, not just first year students, and is designed to foster a more serious academic attitude among all undergraduate students.)

Similar deficiency reports may be submitted for any other students whose work is unsatisfactory, particularly if the student is chronically absent from class.
