MARIOLOGICAL SOCIETY CONVENTION

The sixth annual convention of the Mariological Society of America is scheduled for St. Louis on January 3 and 4, 1955. Archbishop Joseph Ritter of St. Louis and Bishop John Wright of Worcester will take part in the meetings.

The theme of the sixth convention will be Mary's Divine Maternity. Speakers include: Rev. Jasper Chiodini, "The Nature of the Divine Maternity"; Rev. Martin J. Healy, "The Divine Maternity in the Early Church"; Rev. Gerald Van Ackeren, S.J., "Did the Divine Maternity Formally Sanctify Mary's Soul?" Rev. Bernard J. LeFrois, S.V.D., "The Divine Maternity in Sacred Scripture"; Rev. Joseph L. Shannon, O.S.A., "Was Nestorius a Nestorian?" Very Rev. Frank A. Setzer, S.M.M., "The Nexus Between the Divine Maternity and Mary's Other Prerogatives"; Rev. Kenneth Dougherty, S.A., "Contemporary American Protestant Attitudes Toward the Divine Maternity."

The sixth volume of *Marian Studies*, edited by Rev. J. B. Carol, O.F.M., and containing the papers read at the national convention, will be available in the spring of 1955 for \$2.50. All back issues, except volume two, are still in print and available from Father Carol at 600 Sound View Avenue, Bronx 72, New York. All college, seminary, and religious libraries of any size will want the complete set of *Marian Studies* the most valuable Mariological publication in English.

Ad Caeli Regnam, the encyclical letter of Pope Pius XII on the Queenship of Mary, has been chosen as reprint 30 in the Marian Reprint series. It is now available from the Marian Library at 15¢ a copy, thirty copies or more, 10¢ each. An introductory note on the encyclical and a list of the sixty-three references of the document are included in the reprint.

The November reprint (29) was *The Wisdom of Mary*, by Gerald Vann, O.P.
