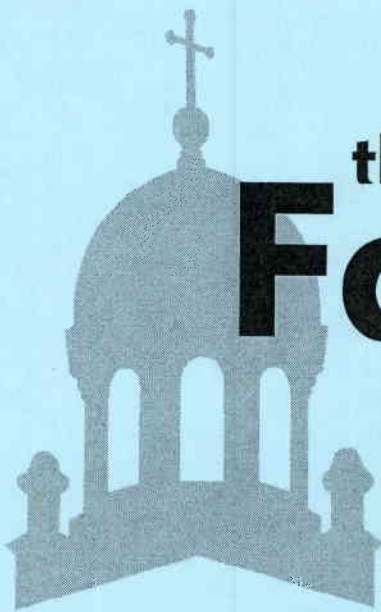

What is new with the Nicene Creed?

The revised creed begins with the words, "I believe..." rather than "We believe". "I believe" is a direct translation of the Latin verb *Credo*. The change in wording also refers back to our renewal of baptismal promises when we respond with "I do" to the belief statements at Easter.

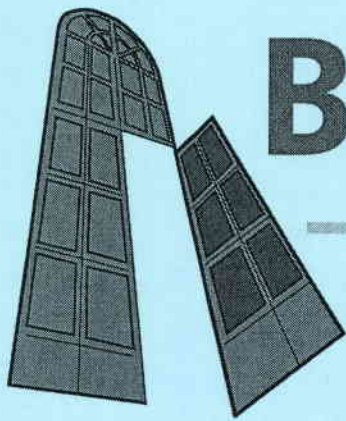
