FOR RELEASE UPON RECEIPT

Congressman Charles W. Whalen, Jr. (R-Ohio) today announced approval of a Concentrated Employment Program for Dayton, Ohio.

The program includes a grant of \$2,087,000 for training costs, trainee allowances and project administration.

The funds will be provided under the Manpower Development and Training Act and the Economic Opportunity Act.

The intent of the program is to provide improved coordination of available manpower training services by establishing a single over-all sponsor to develop specific training projects to meet the needs of target areas residents.

The City of Dayton and the Supporting Council on Preventive Effort (Dayton) are the sponsors. They will mobilize public and private resources in a saturation effort to improve training and employment opportunities for approximately 2,074 unemployed, under-employed and marginally employed persons in the target areas.

The program's major objective is to design and conduct a comprehensive program of employment services, manpower training, job development and employment opportunities for seriously disadvantaged, long-term unemployed residents of areas of high unemployment.

While setting up comprehensive facilities for recruiting and training in the target area, the sponsor also will seek to enlist the participation of employers, organized labor and civic groups in making job opportunities available.

A large number of other health, education and welfare agencies will also be involved.
