FOR RELEASE UPON RECEIPT

Congressman Charles W. Whalen, Jr. (R-Ohio) today announced that two Dayton companies will receive grants to train hard-core jobless under the President's JOBS (Job Opportunities in the Business Sector) program.

The Lowe Brothers Company will train six persons in various occupations under a grant of \$5,538.

Liberal Markets, Inc., will train 10 grocery men under a \$37,508 grant.

The Department of Labor will fund the programs.

The two firms are among 15 companies in 10 Midwestern cities that will train a total of 1,917.

The total federal expenditure will be \$3.9 million to help pay for on-the-job training and extensive services.

The other cities and the numbers of trainees are: Chicago, 23; Cleveland, 1,100; Columbus, 15; Detroit, 120; Milwaukee, 12; Minneapolis, 518; Kansas City, Mo., 38; St. Louis, 25, and Omaha, 50.

The National Alliance of Businessmen participated in the creation of these training proposals.

The JOBS program which is aimed at providing employment for 100,000 jobless in the Nation's 50 largest cities by the end of the year.
