The popular Investment Workshop, directed by George Humm and Stephen Kuflewski of Merrill Lynch, and the short course on "Analysis and Interpretation of Financial Statements" both began Tuesday night. The latter is conducted by R. F. Wenzel of Third National Bank.

Beginning Thursday night are two more short courses.
