FOR RELEASE UPON RECEIPT

Congressman Charles W. Whalen, Jr. (R-Ohio) today announced approval of a \$93,222 grant to the Dayton Public Night School.

The funds will be used to provide 80 unemployed workers with training as clerk-typists in a 23-week program.

The Labor Department and the Health, Education and Welfare Department will finance the project.

The grant represents the federal share of the cost, which is estimated at \$97,250 over-all.

The project is authorized under the provisions of the Manpower Development and Training Act of 1962.

This project was developed and submitted for approval by the Ohio Employment Security and Education agencies.
