Some 50 watercolors and oils, work of the students of the Dayton Art Institute, will be on display next Sunday (Dec. 13) during the 10th annual Christmas Concert by the University-Community chorus in the UD fieldhouse.

Arranged through Dean Edward Burroughs and the student council at the Institute, the exhibition will mark one of the first occasions the students have had the opportunity to show their works on the campus. It also marks the first time another cultural interest has been added to the annual program.

The fieldhouse will be opened at 7:15 p.m. to give the public an opportunity to view the art exhibit for an hour prior to the 8:15 p.m. concert. Highlight of the program this year will be the Christmas portion of Handel's MESSIAH. The 200-voice chorus, largest in the 10-year history of the group, will be accompanied by the 50-piece Dayton Philharmonic Training orchestra and organist Burton Weaver.

The concert, directed by Lawrence E. Tagg, is free to the public.
