1. Minutes from 3/22/19 were approved with no changes.
2. The committee continued to review the proposals to reorganize degree programs in the Health and Sport Science Department.
 - a. The proposals for the BSHS and BSSW were approved (M:S. Dorf, 2 J. Dunne; 7-0).
 - b. A. Crecelius will forward to ECAS for inclusion on future agenda.
3. A draft of the final report from the Transfer Credit Task Force was reviewed and discussed. The committee is supportive of CAP requirements being assessed depending on number of credits completed by transfer students. The committee discussed that further faculty feedback would be helpful for the specific CAP components and how they will be handled.
4. S. Dorf provided an update from ECAS. The April 12th meeting will consist of regular Senate business. There is an effort to hold off on business for the April 26th meeting to allow for new senators to meet in committee assignments for AY 19-20. Committees should be prepared to provide year-end reports at the meeting on the 26th.
