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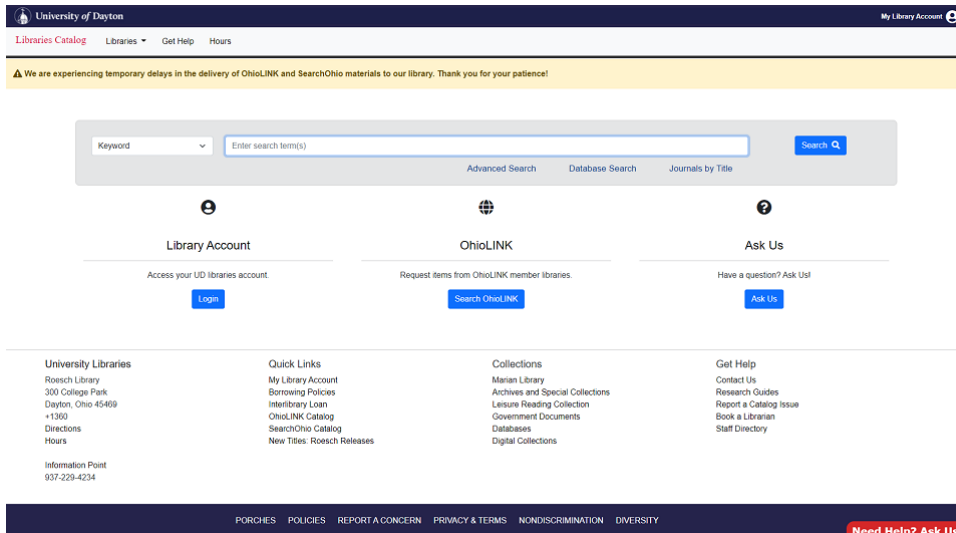

Libraries Catalog: New Design, Functionality on

A longtime resource provided by University Libraries has undergone a redesign informed by best practices and user input. The catalog's new, simplified interface will launch on Wednesday, Aug. 4. The main improvement is its responsive design, meaning that the catalog will resize for a monitor, tablet, smartphone or other device. It also has higher-contrast colors, optional keyboard navigation and other features that improve accessibility.

You may know it as the catalog, a database, or maybe its URL: flyers.udayton.edu. Either way, the catalog facilitates:

- Checking your library account for requests, holds and items out.
- Searching or browsing the print, electronic, media and equipment holdings of the University Libraries.
- Text messaging or saving of bibliographic information to keep track of interesting items.

The redesign will not affect the search interface for [UDiscover](#), another research tool that allows you to simultaneously search the UD catalog, OhioLINK catalog, and many of the online resources available through the University Libraries, in addition to institutional repositories and open-access resources.

Moving, hopeful, and inventive, this extraordinary novel is a vivid portrait of the state of contemporary Britain and the legacy of Britain's colonial history in Africa and the Caribbean. The twelve central characters of this multi-voiced novel lead vastly different lives: Anna is a newly acclaimed playwright whose work often explores her black woman identity, her old friend Shirley is a teacher, jaded after decades of work in London's funding-deprived schools, Carole, one of Shirley's former students, works hard to earn a degree from Oxford and becomes an investment banker, Carole's mother Bunmi works as a cleaner and worries about her daughter's lack of rootedness despite her obvious achievements. decided to pay it forward and asked the campus community to contribute items and ideas to best represent UD and the world in 2019.

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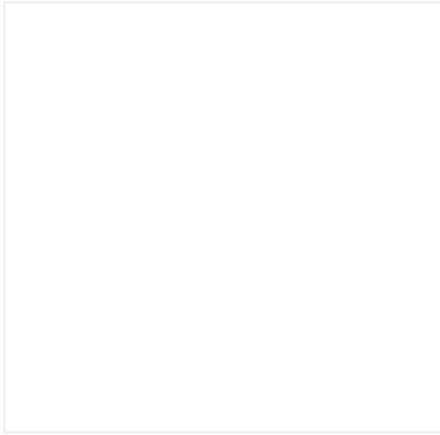


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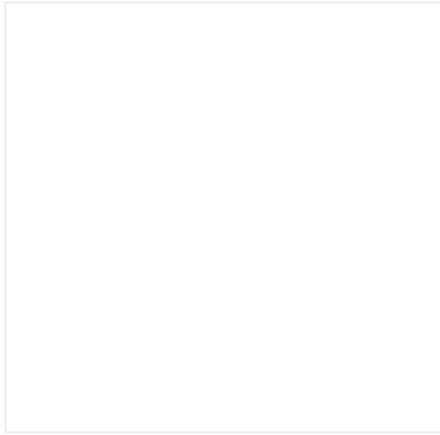
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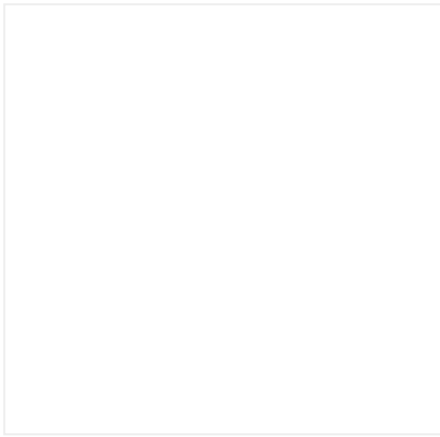
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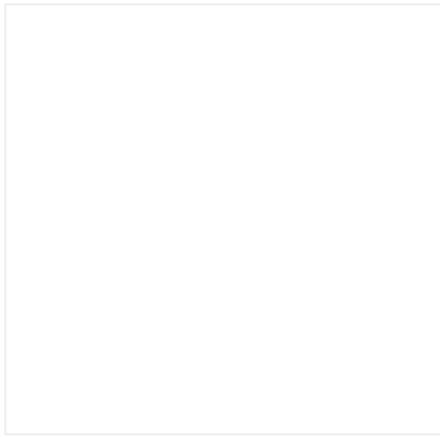
