William F. Pilder, president of Leadership Transitions Solutions, has been a founding partner in three ventures that provided career development and transition services to individuals and major corporations, including the steel, auto and energy industries.

He will speak on "My Pilgrimage with Faith and Work" at 7:30 a.m. Thursday, April 11, at the 1700 South Patterson Building on the University's River Campus.

A 1960 graduate of the University with a degree in secondary education, Pilder earned a master's degree and Ph.D. from The Ohio State University. He is experienced in coaching senior executives and authored a series of eight books for Prentice-Hall on the career transition process.

"Dr. Pilder describes his work as a 'healing intervention with corporations'," said Br. Victor Forlani, S.M., director of the center. "He operated a very effective human resources practice for many years, serving many Fortune 500 firms. I believe his work fits well with what we do at the Center for Integration of Faith and Work."
