The purpose of this study was to examine the perspective of the student body towards Greek Life organizations a on catholic institution campus.

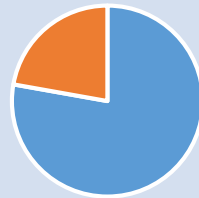

## Findings

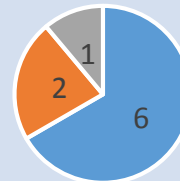
